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Community Assistance Scholarship

This Community Assistance Scholarship is available for the **Phlebotomy Technician Program only**. Jacobs Medical Academy offers a limited number of Community Assistance Scholarship opportunities each year to assist individuals in the community who are experiencing hardship but are motivated to build a better future through healthcare training.

The scholarship reduces the Phlebotomy Technician Program tuition from \$1,446 to \$300 for up to four (4) individuals per year. Applicants must demonstrate commitment, professionalism, and readiness to complete the program.

Required Application Documents

1. Scholarship Request Letter – Explain your situation, why you want to enter healthcare, and how completing the program will help improve your future.
2. Referral Letter – A letter from a shelter, church, mentor, employer, caseworker, or community organization confirming your situation and character.
3. Resume – A resume or short summary of work history, volunteer experience, skills, or career interests.
4. Transportation Confirmation – Confirm that you have reliable transportation to attend class.
5. Program Commitment – Confirm that you will attend class and complete all program requirements.

Selection is not guaranteed. Recipients will be chosen based on financial need, professionalism, commitment, and readiness to successfully complete the program.

Applicants who are selected must be ready to move forward with the \$300 tuition payment to secure their seat in the program.
